Search Tips

<p>How do I find GML OneSearch</p>	<p>Access via the Gorgas Memorial Library website: http://wrair-www.army.mil/OtherServices_Library.aspx or bookmark http://primotc1.hosted.exlibrisgroup.com/primo_library/libweb/action/search.do?dscnt=0&fromLogin=true</p>
<p>How do I search GML OneSearch</p>	<p>It's very easy. Simply enter an author name, keyword or phrase in the search box and click GO (GML Website) or on the Search button to retrieve results when using the bookmarked URL.</p>
<p>How do I find more resources on my topic within my GML OneSearch search?</p>	<p>Go to the Details record for any item that you have determined is valid and appropriate according to the topic on which you are searching. Click on the Subjects: line within the record to retrieve more items with the exact same topic.</p>
<p>How do I look for an article in GML OneSearch?</p>	<p>You may select the desired "Articles" scope in the dropdown box that appears when performing a second search or using the bookmark link noted above. Note: choose "Available at GML" to look for materials available via the Gorgas Memorial Library.</p>
<p>How do I search for and view an e-journal?</p>	<p>Begin by entering keywords on the topic of your choosing. Select Journals as the type of item you are seeking before choosing Full Text Online from the top of the results display. Click on the title to connect to the full-text for the electronic item you want to view.</p> <p>If you want to view the item within the GML OneSearch interface, click on the View Online tab. You may be prompted to log in since Athens Login may be required.</p>
<p>How can I limit my search in GML OneSearch?</p>	<p>You may refine results by date, author, resource type, Collection, etc. by clicking on the categories on the left hand side of the results screen.</p>
<p>May I search using a wildcard?</p>	<p>To perform a single-character wildcard search, enter a ? in place of the character position that has more than one possibility, e.g. wom?n to search for woman, women, etc.</p> <p>To perform a multiple-character wildcard search, enter a * in place of the characters that have multiple possibilities, e.g. vaccin* to search for vaccine, vaccines, vaccination, etc.</p>
<p>How do I search by ISBN or ISSN?</p>	<p>This option is found on the Advanced Search page in the drop-down text menu next to Search Terms.</p> <p>You must enter ISBNs like this: 9780375847387. You must enter ISSNs like this: 1523-388X.</p>
<p>What do I do if the article content is not available online?</p>	<p>Be sure to verify whether the journal in which the desired title appears is available in the physical collection of the library by searching again for the journal title with a scope of "Available at GML". If not, locate the desired article and click on ILL options to select your preferred ILL service.</p>
