

## Finding Online Journal Articles for WRAIR/NMRC Users

### Checking journal availability

When you visit the page for Gorgas Memorial Library (GML) on the WRAIR intranet (<https://wrairintranet.army.mil/ResearchSupport/IMD/GML/Pages/default.aspx>), choose the GML E-Resources link under the Important Links section.

### Google Scholar searches

When you search Google Scholar, you will see holdings for the Gorgas Memorial Library and MRMC LEAP E-Resources listed for certain articles based on your IP address. Clicking on these links should take you to the full text of the article. **NOTE:** For MRMC – LEAP E-Resources, email [usarmy.detrick.medcom-wrair.mbx.gorgas-inter-library-loan@mail.mil](mailto:usarmy.detrick.medcom-wrair.mbx.gorgas-inter-library-loan@mail.mil) if you are not able to access the resources.


